The minutes of the meeting held on 23rd July, 2021, were read and approved.

A. Action taken Report

1. The Chairperson reported the College's NIRF ranking, which had improved by 1 position to render ARSD College the 12th ranked institute in India.
2. The Chairperson announced that the Vice Chancellor of the University of Delhi would officially launch the Vidya Vistar Scheme on Monday, 27 September 2021 at 10.30 am. ARSD College has adopted two Uttarakhand Colleges under this Scheme in an effort to aid innovation and capacity building across institutions. The MoU between colleges was signed on 15 September 2021.
3. The Chairperson was happy to report that the inauguration of College's In-House Interdisciplinary Research and Innovation Projects Scheme and the Vidya Vistar Scheme will be launched on 27 September 2021.
4. The College is scheduled to hold its second two-day Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) on 30th September and 1st October 2021. The Chairperson highlighted the fact that it would be conducted by a completely external team.
5. The promotion of faculty members across departments and scales is in full swing and pay fixation of the promoted faculty members is also under process.
6. The College was certified as the District Green Champion by MGNCRE, Government of India in August 2021.

B. Minutes

1. The Committee congratulated the IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Vinita Tuli and her team for their meticulous work in compiling data for NIRF and *India Today*.
2. Dr. Jaya Tomar and her team's unstinting efforts to ensure transparency and efficiency during the Promotions process were highly lauded as well.
3. Prof. Chaturvedi commended the Committee and the many teams involved for their hard work and dedication, giving them their due for College's excellent progress in the last five years, and consistent rise in rankings. With a push in certain dedicated areas, he was certain ARSD would soon become one of the top ten colleges in the country.
4. The Committee discussed College's performance in various parameters and focused on research publications and public perception as areas with scope for improvement. Various strategies were discussed, from incentivizing individual faculty members to highlighting College achievements on the website and through its social media channels.
5. Prof. Chaturvedi recommended optimizing social media content to draw attention to events within the College on a regular basis. He also suggested creating micro sites for research activities and publications, highlighting these attainments on the website. These changes would result in a positive shift in public perception and would also draw the attention of prospective candidates. In addition, he spoke of segregating tasks related to specific parameters, such as research, teaching-learning, infrastructure, etc., among dedicated teams to ensure maximal efficiency.

6. Mr. S.C. Jha also focused on the culture of decentralized administration and sub-committees that had held the College in good stead through the first cycle of NAAC assessment. Given the approaching deadline for the second cycle of NAAC, he stressed the need to maintain this effective compartmentalization of labour in order to best achieve desired results.
7. DR. V.K. Arora spoke of improving the perception of the College in the eyes of the students, emphasizing their role in changing community perceptions. Through collective efforts, galvanizing the media and projecting College's success in a sustained manner, he was sure changes could be made.
8. Other members also spoke of the role of the Press and the need to engage them consistently to broadcast College's accomplishments on the wider plane.
9. Mr. Bhushan spoke of the need to make the alumni aware of the many changes that have taken place in the College, keeping them in the loop and eliciting their cooperation. This would also, he felt, bring about a shift in College's perception.
10. Prof. Thakur and Prof. Chaturvedi spoke at length about the need to scale up College's research potential, accentuation on the need for more institutional collaborations along with amplifying individual research output. Discussed were various means of encouraging faculty members and the student body to undertake more research—from recognizing publications through certificates to highlighting them on the website. To this end, the Chairperson, Prof. G.K. Jha spoke on focusing on key areas for improvement and the role of the In-House Research Cell in motivating on-campus academic research activities.
